Class: 3A Name: Wong Chung Yin

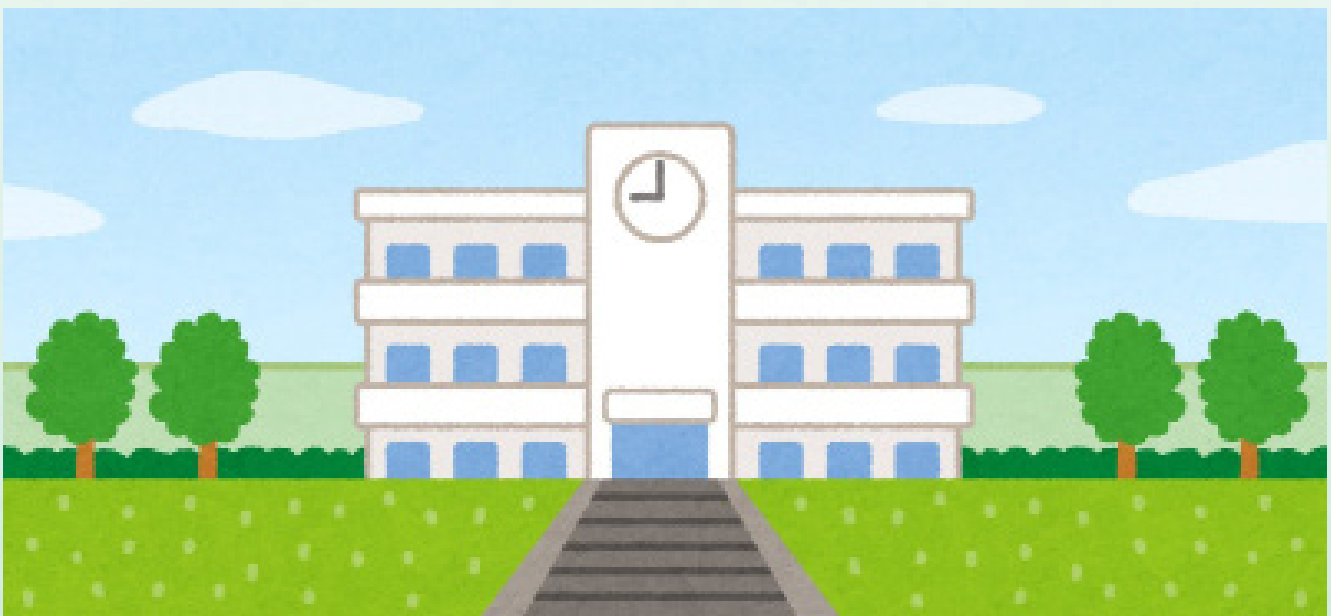
I love my school very much. It is a beautiful place for learning so that I can create a lot of joyful and unforgettable moments there. Do you want to know more about my blissful moments at school?
